If you are trying to reach us at a busy time and there are more than 10 people in the queue you will be offered a call back. The system will hold your place for you and when you reach the front of the queue, we will phone you back.





The NHS App

The NHS App provides NHS services 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. It is very secure and helps practices manage demand, reduce administrative work and enhance patient and staff experiences. All patients can have access and benefit from features like:

Prescription ordering, appointment management and viewing health records.
